[Tools4CAP](#), which stands for Innovative Toolbox empowering effective CAP governance towards EU ambitions, is a Coordination and Support Action in Horizon Europe (2023-2026) coordinated by Ecorys, gathering 20 partner organisations.

The project aims to support the design and monitoring of the national Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) Strategic Plans (SPs) 2023-2027 and lay the foundations for sound preparation of Post-2027 Strategic Plans through a bottom-up adaptation of innovative methods and tools.

Tools4CAP wants to promote a meaningful engagement of end users, and other external actors, that goes beyond sharing results but includes their feedback in the conceptualisation of the tasks in order to make them as useful as possible. The specific objectives of the Info Session are:
